The role is flexible so can work around other commitments, you decide which days you volunteer and we reimburse you monthly for your fuel costs.

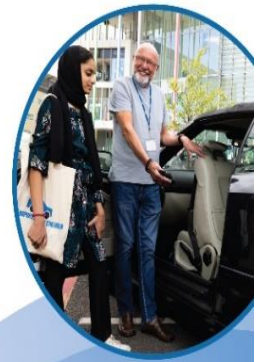
